# Tracing the Descendants of Robert and Dinah Dale

# OBJECTIVE

The objective for this research session was to trace the descendants of Robert Dale in search of potential autosomal and Y-DNA test takers, seeking matches to the descendants of William Munford Stubbs. Robert was an agricultural laborer born on 30 August 1801 in Bracon Ash, Norfolk, England. Robert married Dinah Dawson on 13 October 1823 in Wreningham, Norfolk, England. He died in April 1879 in Flordan, Norfolk, England.

## LIMITATIONS

- This research for this project was conducted during two-week period.
- Records for people born after 1939 are limited in England. Tracing living individuals could be difficult depending on record availability.
- The research for this session was confined to records that could be obtained online.

## **RESULTS SUMMARY**

- Used baptism, census, and death records to identify fourteen children of Robert Dale and Dinah Dawson.
- Correlated census, church, and civil records to trace descendants of five of the couple's children. Presented a genealogical summary of the descendancy research in a descending genealogy format.
- Discovered three avenues for tracing living autosomal DNA test takers: William Henry Huges III who lived in Houston, Texas, in 1953, Malcolm Steven Porter, who lived in

Ditchingham Dam, Bungay, Suffolk, England in 2002, and Malcolm's brother Andrew John Porter.

# BACKGROUND INFORMATION

This research project is part of a larger ongoing project to identify the father of William Munford Stubbs. William was born to Ann Munford on 23 June 1858.<sup>1</sup> The birth record did not name his father. William was enumerated in his grandfather Robert Munford's household in 1861 under the surname Munford.<sup>2</sup> When immigrating to the United States, Ann was listed as a spinster (never married), and her son William was listed with her surname, Mumford [sic].<sup>3</sup> In 1870, William was enumerated with the surname of his stepfather, George Gunn.<sup>4</sup>

The 1880 census is the first record on which William's surname was listed as Stubbs, or Stubs, as it was spelled on this record.<sup>5</sup> He used this surname for the rest of his life, and his descendants carry that surname. Family lore suggests that William might have chosen the surname himself and that it wasn't his biological father's surname.

Y-DNA test results for one of William's great-grandsons suggest two possible surnames: Dale and Brock.<sup>6</sup> The matches with these surnames are distant. The estimated common ancestor for the closest match (surname Dale) would have occurred around 1700 AD.<sup>7</sup>

Based on the surnames Dale and Brock appearing in Y-DNA test results, families with these surnames who lived within a five-mile radius of Ann (in Hethel) and her parents (in Wymondham) between 1851 and 1861 were sought in a previous research session.<sup>8</sup> No Brock

families were discovered in the area, but several Dale families were identified. Current research is focusing on tracing the descendants of these families to find living individuals who can be asked to take an autosomal or a Y-DNA test to see if they match descendants of William Munford Stubbs. This research session focused on the descendants of Robert and Dinah (Dawson) Dale of Wreningham.

#### GENEALOGICAL BACKGROUND




Figure 1. Parishes of Interest in Norfolk County, England

Robert and Dinah (Dawson) Dale lived in Wreningham from the time they married until at least 1851. They moved to the neighboring parish of Flordon by 1854, when Dinah died and was buried there (for a map of these parishes in relation to Wymondaham and Hethel, see Figure 1 below). Birth years and places for each of their children were taken from the 1841 and 1851 censuses.

Robert and Dinah Dale Family Timeline

- 1801: Robert Dale was born in Bracon Ash, Norfolk, England, on 30 August.<sup>9</sup>
- **1807:** Dinah Dawson was born in Wreningham, Norfolk, England.<sup>10</sup>
- **1823:** Robert Dale married Dinah Dawson in Wreningham on 30 October.<sup>11</sup>
- **1824:** James Dale was born in Norfolk, England.<sup>12</sup>
- **1827:** John Dale was born in Wreningham.<sup>13</sup>
- **1830:** David Dale was born in Norfolk.<sup>14</sup>

- **1834:** Robert Dale was baptized on 8 June in Flordon, Norfolk, England.<sup>15</sup> The 1851 census states he was born in Wreningham.<sup>16</sup>
- **1837:** Sarah Dale was born in Wreningham.<sup>17</sup>
- **1840:** Elizabeth Dale was born in Wreningham.<sup>18</sup>
- **1841:** Robert Dale and his family lived in Wreningham.<sup>19</sup> Daniel Dale was born the same year in Wreningham.<sup>20</sup>
- **1845:** William Dale was born in Wreningham.<sup>21</sup>
- **1851:** Robert Dale and his family lived in Wreningham.<sup>22</sup>
- 1854: Dinah Dale died in March in Flordon.<sup>23</sup>

- **1861:** A widowed Robert Dale lived in Flordon.<sup>24</sup> His son Robert Jr. was serving in the Royal Navy and was enumerated aboard his vessel, the *Torch* this year.<sup>25</sup>
- **1871:** Robert Dale lived in Flordon.<sup>26</sup>
- **1879:** Robert Dale died in Flordon in April.<sup>27</sup>

#### LOCALITY BACKGROUND

The parishes of Wreningham and Flordan neighbor one another (see figure 1). Table 1 below defines the jurisdictions for these parishes.

Civil registration of vital records began in England in 1837, so vital records for each of the children in the family should be available except birth records for the eldest sons, James, John, David, and Robert. While events might still be kept in parish records, this was done less frequently, so vital records might be the best source for births, marriages, and deaths for subsequent generations.<sup>28</sup> Census records through 1921 will also be valuable for tracing the families.

Migration could be a factor for the research on this family. In the decade from 1851 to 1861, almost 42,000 Norfolk residents migrated to London, and another 11,000 migrated to Middlesex, Surrey, Kent, and Essex. Migration into the more urban areas of Norfolk County like Norwich was also common.<sup>29</sup>

Not all migrants remained in urban areas after their initial migration. Sixty-eight percent of the migrants who survived to 1871 remained in London. Some, like female servants saving for a dowry for marriage, returned home to Norfolk.<sup>30</sup>

# FINDINGS AND ANALYSIS

#### BAPTISM RECORDS FOR THE CHILDREN OF ROBERT DALE AND DINAH DAWSON

The Church of England, or the Anglican Church, has been the national church since the 16<sup>th</sup> century and therefore, the most common church in England during the time the Robert and Dinah (Dawson) Dale were having children.<sup>31</sup> Parish records are widely available online and are helpful for discovering the children of a couple. They usually include the father's occupation, making them valuable for ensuring that the correct couple has been identified. Prior to the start of this research session, the baptism record for Robert Dale Jr. was located in the Church of England Records in Flordon Parish.<sup>32</sup> Seeking baptisms for additional children of this couple would help ensure that all descendants can be traced.

Parish records revealed baptisms for ten children of Robert and Dinah (Dawson) Dale. Census and death records revealed four additional children born to the couple. These children and the records documenting their parentage are listed in Generation One of the Genealogical Summary below.

#### CIVIL REGISTRATION IN ENGLAND

In addition to parish records, civil registration of births, marriages, and deaths began in 1837 in England. They often provide parent names (including the mother's maiden name), their addresses, and the father's occupation. These documents were useful for many of the individuals studied during this research session. Indexes are widely available, but they contain only minimal information. The originals must be ordered from the General Register Office in Southport. Digital images of birth and death records can be obtained instantly for a small fee. Marriage records must be ordered and mailed via snail mail. However, if the individuals married in the Anglican church after 1837, the church marriage register will be an exact duplicate of the civil marriage.<sup>33</sup> Church marriage records were valuable for this research project.

#### ENGLAND CENSUS RECORDS

Censuses were taken in England every ten years beginning in 1801.<sup>34</sup> The first listing of individuals by name was in 1841. Records from 1841 through 1921 are extant and readily available, having been digitized and added to several major family history websites.

Census records were valuable sources for this research session, providing the names, ages, birthplaces, and occupations of each household member. Correlating the information from censuses with church and vital records was the key methodology that helped ascertain whether the correct family members were being followed. In some instances, it was impossible to tell whether the correct family member had been identified. These instances are noted in the Genealogical Summary and notes about how to positively identify them have been added to the Suggestions for Future Research.

While not technically considered a census, the 1939 England and Wales Register was also a valuable tool for this research session. It is especially valuable because the 1931 census was destroyed during WWII, and no census was taken in 1941 due to the ongoing conflict.<sup>35</sup> The Register was used to create National Identity Cards, facilitate ration books, and record the movement of the civilian population over the following decades. Some names have been redacted from this record, to protect the privacy of the living. The record is updated annually to reveal individuals born more than 100 years ago, or whose death has been reported to the National Archives. These redactions helped identify possible living family members among the descendants of Robert and Dinah Dale.

#### PROBATE RECORDS

Probate records have not yet been thoroughly searched for Robert and Dinah Dale's descendants. One will for one descendant identified her sons and might help extend their lines. The time allotted for this research session did not allow for thorough research on the 4<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> generations. As this research is continued, probate records will become very valuable.

#### THE NGSQ NUMBERING SYSTEM

To organize the descendancy research for this session, a system of outlining the research for each generation was needed. The NGS Quarterly numbering system is a user-friendly format for compiling a descending genealogy and was utilized for the genealogical summary below.<sup>36</sup> The key below will help understand this numbering system:

**Generation Number:** a superscripted, italicized number following the first name of a person in a main entry and the first child in a child list. *Example:* Robert<sup>*i*</sup> Dale.

**Individual Numbers:** Every person is assigned a person number. This number is followed by a period for a main entry and no period in the child list. The numbers do not start over with each family. *Example:* **1. Robert**<sup>*t*</sup> **Dale.** 

**Child Lists:** Children in each family are numbered with small roman numerals following their individual number. Each child in a family who has a main entry in the next generation is designated with a + sign before his or her individual number. *Example:* + 2 i. James<sup>2</sup> Dale.

**Generational Reference:** When an individual is listed in a main entry, their descent from the original ancestor is listed after their name. *Example:* **42. Rosa Lillian**<sup>4</sup> **Dale** (William John<sup>3</sup>, William<sup>2</sup>, Robert<sup>1</sup>).

# GENEALOGICAL SUMMARY

### Generation One

**1. Robert**<sup>1</sup> **Dale**, born about 1802 in Bracon Ash, Norfolk, England; died about 1879 in Flordon, Norfolk, England. He married on 13 October 1823 at Wreningham, **Dinah Dawson**, daughter of Robert Dawson and Mary Elmer.

Known children of Robert Dale<sup>1</sup> and Dinah Dawson were as follows:

- + 2 i. JAMES<sup>2</sup> DALE, (Robert<sup>1</sup>), baptized 29 February 1824 in Wreningham, Norfolk, England;<sup>37</sup> married Elizabeth Hancock.<sup>38</sup>
  - 3 ii. JOHN DALE, baptized 20 August 1826 in Wreningham.<sup>39</sup> No further information has been discovered about John.

A railway miner and platelayer by trade, James lived in Campden, Warwickshire, by 1851 and Bourton on the Water, Gloucestershire, by 1857.<sup>64</sup> Census records for James state that he

was born in Flordon about 1823.<sup>65</sup> He could have been the James Dale who was the son of Noah and Mary and was baptized on 24 July 1825.<sup>66</sup> Further research is needed to determine whether this James was the son of Robert Dale and Dinah Dawson. A marriage record might name James's father. This record could be sought in a future research session.

**9. Robert<sup>2</sup> Dale**, (Robert<sup>1</sup>), baptized 8 June 1834 at Flordon, Norfolk, England;<sup>71</sup> died 8 May 1875 in Gillingham, Kent, England.<sup>72</sup> He married on 28 November 1869 at Gillingham, Kent, England, **Mary Ann Brooks**, daughter of James Charles Brooks.<sup>73</sup>

Robert Jr. appears to have joined the Royal Navy on 25 June 1859, volunteering for a period of ten years. He must have renewed his service, as his military records extend to 1875. He served as a "stoker" on the ships *Minotaur* (1859), *Cumberland* (1860, 64, and 68), *Torch* (1859-60), *Indus* (1864), *Achilles* (1864-1868), *Fawn* (1869-1875), and *Pembroke* (1875).<sup>74</sup> He died while on leave on 8 May 1875.<sup>75</sup>

Robert's military service records state that he was born in Flordon in May 1839.<sup>76</sup> His marriage record provides the name of his father, Robert Sr.<sup>77</sup> Civil registration of births in England began in 1837, and no record for a birth of Robert Dale in Flordon exists in 1839.<sup>78</sup> However, Robert Dale (son of Robert Dale and Dinah Dawson) was baptized in Flordon on 8 June 1834.<sup>79</sup> Perhaps he was born in May of that year. It is uncertain why Robert would have

reported a birth date five years later than his actual birth date when he entered into naval service.

Mary Ann Brooks named Robert Dale as the father of five children (see child list below). All but the eldest, Clara Elizabeth, were born after Robert's death. While he could have fathered the second child Lily, who was born in December 1875, he could not have been the father of Augusta (born 1879), William Henry (born 1880), or Agnes Lucy (born 1883). William Henry's descendant has hypothesized that at least the youngest three children – and possibly Lily – were the biological children of James Hall, enumerated as a lodger in Mary Ann's household in 1881.<sup>80</sup>

**11. Elizabeth<sup>2</sup> Dale** (Robert<sup>1</sup>), born about 1840 in Wreningham, Norfolk, England;<sup>88</sup> died 30 January 1926 in Flordon, Norfolk, England<sup>89</sup> Never married.

Elizabeth Dale appears to have borne at least two children but never married. In 1861, she and her presumed son Benjamin Dale lived with Elizabeth's father Robert in Flordon.<sup>90</sup> It is uncertain where Elizabeth was in 1871, but her children Benjamin and Ellen lived with their grandfather Robert Dale.<sup>91</sup> Elizabeth's location in 1881 is uncertain, but by 1891, she lived on her own with her thirty-one-year-old son Benjamin, working as a seamstress.<sup>92</sup> Elizabeth continued living in Flordon until her death in 1926.<sup>93</sup>

William Dale's marriage record provides the name of his father, Robert Dale.<sup>105</sup> Census records after his marriage consistently state that he was born in Wreningham about 1845-46.<sup>106</sup> This birth information aligns with information on census records prior to his marriage.<sup>107</sup>

The time allotted for this research session did not allow for the complete study of each of William's children. They could be traced in a future research session if desired.

On her marriage record, Ellen's father was listed as Benjamin Bunn (deceased), a scavenger.<sup>136</sup> Her mother Elizabeth never married Benjamin.<sup>137</sup> Ellen died young, at age thirtyeight.<sup>138</sup> Ellen's daughters were enumerated with her widowed husband in Stratton, Norfolk, in 1911.<sup>139</sup> Her daughters likely never married. In 1939, they both lived in the same household.<sup>140</sup> Dora, age forty-four worked as a cook, and Ellen, age 46, worked as a house parlour maid. She was both deaf and dumb. Both daughters died and were buried with their maiden names. They appear to have never married or had children.

**54.** Hazel Olive<sup>5</sup> Larter (Rosa Lillian<sup>4</sup>, William John<sup>3</sup>, William<sup>2</sup>, Robert<sup>1</sup>), born 28 February 1926;<sup>180</sup> died 27 April 2002 in Gorleston, Norfolk, England.<sup>181</sup> She married in July 1950 in Lothingland Registration District, Suffolk County, England, Ivan C. Porter.<sup>182</sup>

Hazel left a will in which she named her son Malcolm Steven Porter Ditchingham Dam, Bungay, Suffolk, England, as the executor.<sup>183</sup> Malcolm and her other son Andrew John Porter were the only beneficiaries named in the will. Additional research is needed to determine whether **Malcom Steven Porter** and **Andrew John Porter** are still living and whether they had children.

Known children of Hazel Olive Larter and Ivan C. Porter include the following:

- 55. i. MALCOLM STEVEN<sup>6</sup> PORTER. No further information discovered during this session.
- 56. ii. ANDREW JOHN PORTER. No further information discovered during this session.

# CONCLUSIONS

At the conclusion of this research session, much progress was made toward the objective of discovering DNA test takers among the descendants of Robert and Dinah (Dawson) Dale. Three avenues for tracing autosomal DNA test takers have been identified: William Henry Huges III who lived in Houston, Texas, in 1953, Malcolm Steven Porter, who lived in Ditchingham Dam, Bungay, Suffolk, England in 2002, and Malcolm's brother Andrew John Porter. Modern records could reveal whether they have children who could take a test

The research on other lines in the family has laid the foundation for further work that can be done to seek additional candidates for DNA testing.

# SUGGESTIONS FOR FUTURE RESEARCH

- Determine whether #2 James<sup>2</sup> Dale who lived in Bourton on the Water was the son of Robert Dale and Dinah Dawson or Noah and Mary Dale.
  - Discover a marriage record for James Dale and Elizabeth Hancock. They likely married about 1856, perhaps in Paxford, Worcestershire, England (Elizabeth's birthplace). The marriage record could name James's father.
- Seek additional information about #7 David<sup>2</sup> Dale (Robert<sup>1</sup>), who was baptized 27 March 1831 in Wreningham. If he lived to adulthood, trace his descendants.
- Trace the descendants of #12 Daniel<sup>2</sup> Dale (Robert<sup>1</sup>) and Elizabeth George:
  - Verify that the Daniel Dale who married Elizabeth George was indeed the son of Robert Dale and Dinah Dawson. A marriage record might name his father.
  - Daughter Ellen Dale, born 1876 in Hapton, Norfolk, England.
  - Son Herbert Dale, born 1877 in Hapton.
  - Discover additional children on census records after 1881.
- Trace the following descendants of #13 William<sup>2</sup> Dale (Robert<sup>1</sup>) and Susanna Taylor.
  - Elizabeth Dale (born 1870 in Hapton).
  - John Henry Dale (born 1874 in Hapton).
  - Sarah Elizabeth Dale (born 1880 in Flordon).
- Trace the following descendants of #18 Clara Elizabeth<sup>3</sup> Dale (Robert<sup>2</sup>, Robert<sup>1</sup>) and William Joseph Hughes:
  - Cyril Hughes, born about 1909 in Chatham.
